Child Services.</p> <p>If the caregiver has custody, they can apply at JFS for medical along with the “Child Only Benefits”.</p>
<p>Kinship Permanency Incentive Program:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Caregivers must have received custody from a court proceeding on or after July 1, 2005 Caregivers are eligible for a total of 8 payments over a 48 month period. 	<p>Courts must have awarded legal custody or guardianship of the child to the grandparent, relative or other kinship caregiver, based on the best interest of the child. A Public Children's Services Agency must have been involved and completed the relative approval process including a criminal background check.
